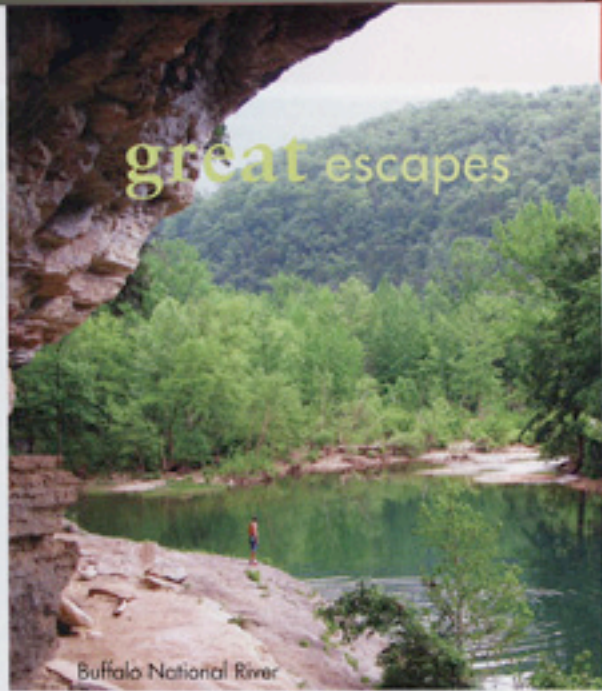

Anedodi: "Adventure" Mountain Lodge

Set on 12 acres and overlooking Lake Norfork in the Ozark Mountains of Arkansas, a new luxury lodge is now available for a week-long family escape. Anedodi, named after the Cherokee word meaning "adventure," is an eco-conscious opulent getaway destination. The lodge features three bedrooms and three bathrooms, and each detail in the home—design, materials and décor—is impeccable.

A relaxing mountain hideaway, Anedodi has a "green" design. The lodge features low-VOC paints, recycled and recyclable materials, organic fabrics, reclaimed woods, indigenous plants, energy-reducing pool features, Energy Star appliances, and natural stones.

Outfitted with the latest in electronics, the indoor rooms provide entertainment for both child and adult with DVD and Blu-ray players, Wii Nintendo and HDTV flat screen televisions. The lodge is stocked with a DVD and Blu-ray library, puzzles, games and books. The kitchen is a contemporary-style space that comes fully stocked with bakeware, utensils, pots and pans. Outside on the deck, the home features a grill and barbecue area with comfortable chairs and couches.

Families can venture outdoors and take a dip in the private 40-foot swimming pool facing Lake Norfork; play Frisbee golf on the lodge's personal 9-hole course; play a game of shuffleboard or horseshoe in the 48-foot game pit; relax on a 600-square-foot deck; or enjoy hiking through 6 private acres of wildlife trails. Hammocks and lounge chairs are placed throughout the property's acreage for relaxation and enjoyment.

There are also opportunities for boating, fishing, skiing and other water-themed activities on Lake Norfork. At the nearby Tracy Ferry Marina, a family staying at Anedodi may dock their own boat or rent one from the marina—pontoon, ski and fishing boats are available. Water sports equipment is also available for rent. With shorelines owned by the US Army Corp of Engineers, Lake Norfork offers 500 miles of hiking opportunities in addition to the property surrounding Anedodi. A favorite hiking and mountain biking trail is the Pigeon Creek Trail System.

Norfolk and Bull Shoals lakes are also world-renowned for fishing—known for trout in particular. The Norfolk Trout Hatchery, located just 15 minutes from Anedodi, is a federal hatchery at the Norfolk Lake Dam and is available to tour. At Dry Run Creek, catch-and-release fishing opportunities are available for disabled youths 16 and under. The facility is handicapped-accessible and is also located at the Norfolk Lake Dam. A range of other activities—five-star golf courses, batting cages, horseback riding, stock car racing, go-carts and movie theaters—are near Anedodi, in case family members want to venture out of the lodge.
